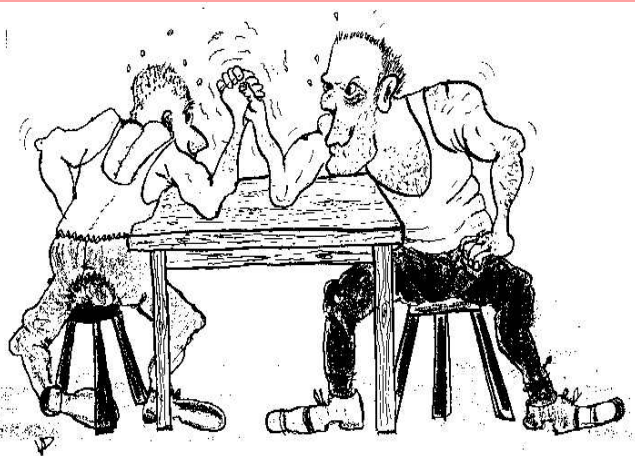

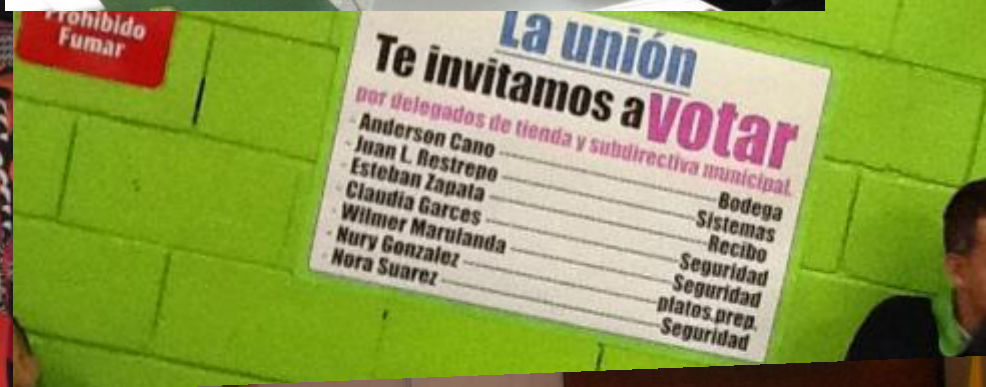

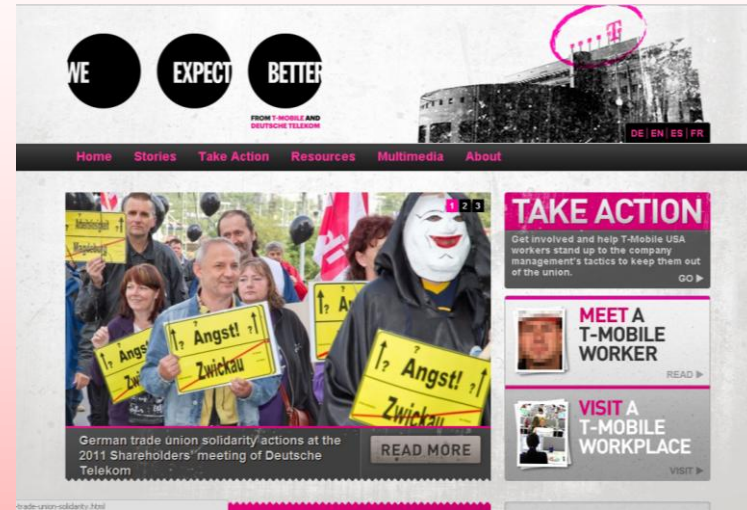

Benetton remains the only major brand with direct links to the Rana Plaza factory that refuses to contribute to the U.N. supported compensation fund. Inspections update

- 🕒 > **1500** factories inspected
- 🕒 **19** buildings evacuated due to structural integrity
- 🕒 9 have re-opened
- 🕒 > **110** factories in critical state needing immediate measures
- 🕒 **+300 common** factories Accord & Alliance;

INSPECTION FINDINGS

- In 950 factories where Corrective Action Plans have been approved, **over 55,000** safety violations.
- Prediction: 100,000+ safety violations in all factories.
- Dangerous hazards in every building
- Most violations are electrical, followed by fire.
