The aim of this conference is to promote ICTU policy on Palestine and to strengthen the contribution of TUFP and the trade union movement here to Palestinian solidarity and to the BDS campaign. Speakers will include **Riya Hassan**, European BDS coordinator, **Hazem Jamjourn**, founding member of Israeli Apartheid Week and advocate for Palestinian refugee rights, **Shir Hever**, Israeli economist and BDS activist, and **Merav Amir**, Israeli academic and BDS activist from Who Profits. The work of TUFP will be reviewed. BDS information packs will be made available, and there will be discussion on how best to implement BDS within affiliate unions and trades councils.

All trade unions, branches, trades union councils and individual members with an interest in supporting Palestinian solidarity are invited to participate in this conference.
