

QQI Level 6 Certificate Course in Trade Union Studies

Evening Programme

2016-2017

We are taking the opportunity this year to roll out the ICTU/SIPTU QQI Level 6 Certificate in Trade Union Studies in Waterford in the coming academic year 2016-2017.

There are six modules to be undertaken, which can be achieved within a fifteen month period with the awarding of a QQI Level 6 Certificate on successful completion of the programme. The modules of the course will be delivered on a consecutive basis of one class per week for ten weeks.

The six modules covered are: Introduction to Irish Employment Law; Collective Bargaining and The Theory and Practice of Negotiation; Human Resource Management; Safety, Health and Welfare at Work; Equality & Diversity and Introduction to Economics.

The course is available to members of Congress-affiliated unions and will be suitable for those who want to further their studies in trade union issues and employment law. In general, members wishing to participate should seek to get the nomination of their union.

There is a cost of €200 per module. In some cases unions may be able to assist members with this fee. Check with your union for details.
